## Bloat / Torsion . GDV

Bloat, also called gastric torsion or GDV is an incredibly painful, life-threatening condition that requires emergency veterinary treatment, sadly even with prompt treatment it can still be fatal, as the movement of the stomach causes a stretching of the gastric wall, which prevents circulation and oxygen reaching the tissues properly, this can lead to necrosis, haemorrhaging, and multiple other issues affecting the whole body, all reducing the chances of survival.

So it is imperative to get to a Vet immediately if your Bloodhound displays any of the following -

- Restlessness
- Retching
- Excessive drooling
- Abdominal pain
- Fast breathing and heart rate
- Distended abdomen once a twist has occurred the stomach will swell rapidly
